





INTRODUCTION




Short of all moving to Iceland, clearly the next best thing we can do here is to give books to one another at Christmas, and to buy those books from independent bookshops. A bookshop – like a library – is a wildwood, time-machine, galaxy and theatre all rolled into one. It contains multitudes. Bookshops also (as I learned earlier this year, while travelling from indie bookstore to indie bookstore in Trump's America) hold open vital civic space, where ideas can circulate freely, and dissenting stories and voices can be heard.

My first book, Mountains of the Mind, was published 22 years ago (gulp...), and two indie bookshops (Topping & Co. and Stanfords) were among its first supporters. Indies and I have remained

close allies ever since. For Independent Bookshop Week in 2015, I wrote a little book called *The Gifts of Reading* which has gone on to raise more than £20,000 to help save migrant lives at sea. And indies were the absolute engines behind helping my book *Is A River Alive?* reach many readers earlier this year. Indie booksellers of the country – for your knowledge, passion and generosity of spirit, I salute you!

Oh – and for my personal Christmasbook-flood this year, I'll be giving Robert Goddard's This Is the Night They Come For You, Tash Aw's The South, Kiran Desai's The Loneliness of Sonia and Sunny, and Philippe Sands' 38 Londres Street.
